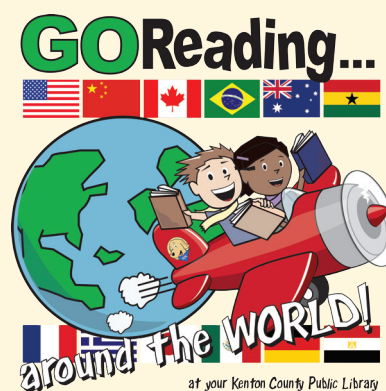

Adults
